

2	lb	ground beef
1		onion, chopped
1	pkg	taco seasoning
1	can	(16 oz) Mexican style tomatoes
2	cans	(16 oz) stewed tomatoes, diced
2	cans	(16 oz) ranch style beans
1	can	(16 oz) corn
1	can	(7 oz) Ortega green chilies
1	can	hominy, optional
