# Pumpkin Curry Soup Georgia Nelson

1 large onion, sliced

1/4 cup butter

1/2 tsp. Curry powder

2 cups canned pumpkin (Libby's is best)

1 1/2 tsp. Salt

2 cups cream, half and half, or nonfat half and half

2 1/2 cups chicken broth

Saute sliced onion in butter until limp. Sprinkle with curry powder and sauté an additional minute or two. Put curried onions, pumpkin and salt in blender. Process until mixed, then quickly pour in cream and blend again. Transfer purée to large saucepan and heat slowly with chicken broth. Serve steaming hot. Makes 1 1/2 quarts. If you double the recipe, make in two separate batches in order to fit in blender.
