**(my mother, Marjorie Adair's, recipe)**

2 egg whites at room temperature	1 tsp vanilla
pinch of salt	1/2 C sugar
1 C mini chocolate chips (I use regular ones)	1 C chopped pecans

Preheat oven to 300 degrees.

Beat egg whites until they hold a shape, then add vanilla and salt. Continue beating while gradually adding sugar until mixture is thick and glossy. Fold in chocolate chips and pecans. Drop by spoonfulls onto foil lined cookie sheets. Bake for 30 minutes. Turn off oven and leave in oven to dry out until oven is cool.

Mix all ingredients and put into casserole. Bake at 350° for 1/2 hour.

Combine beans, corn, bell pepper, green onions and cilantro in a bowl. Combine vinegar, salsa, garlic and cumin and pour over vegetables and mix well. Chill for at least 30 minutes. Salad tastes best when chilled overnight. Serve on a bed of finely shredded cabbage with baked tortilla chips. Serves 4.

### GOOD NEWS ON RALEY'S & FOOD MAXX SHARE CARDS

I have good news to report on our share cards as a fundraiser for our church budget. This past month we received a check from Raley's for \$71.47 for our Raley's Something Extra Cards. For the year to date we have received a total of \$390.98. And we received a check from Food Maxx for \$166.68 on our Food Maxx Share Cards. For the year to date we have received a total of \$730.95. Put the two cards together and we have made \$1121.93 for our church budget.

Just swipe your card when you pay for your groceries. A portion of what you spend for your groceries comes back to your church. If you don't have a Raley's Something Extra Card you just ask for one while you are shopping in Raley's. Raley's does require you to designate how much you want to come back to your church. Raley's requires you to do this on line on your own computer. If you don't have a computer or you have trouble setting this up see Elaine Klein. If you don't have a Food Maxx Share Card see Ginger Ewalt. I understand we just got some new Food Maxx Share Cards but your old card still works just fine.

I want to personally say thank you to Bill Cheek for being our church treasurer for the last year and a half. When Bill became treasurer he said it was only temporary. Temporary became a year and a half. While he was our treasurer he started some new ways to pay our bills that saves the church money. this has worked out very well. I will not be changing anything. We will follow what Bill has taught us. Bill has become my friend . A very good friend indeed. I will miss working with him. He has been working with me and teaching me what he has been doing and I have learned very quickly. He has agreed to help me until I can do everything very well when I need the help.

Since Bill has resigned as our treasurer as of December 31, 2014 we need a person to act as our treasurer. The job will be very easy and will not require you to have a great deal of financial knowledge. You will be mainly a messenger. You will not be required to sign checks. that will be handled by one of our check signers. You will be required to help get bills down to Eagle Tax where our bills are being paid. Eagle Tax is located in The Mission Square shopping center so it will not be a great distance. Most bills are being paid on line or by check. Eagle Tax mails the checks. It will be necessary to pick up payroll checks and take them back to the church. Payroll must be paid on time .Our payroll is due on the 15th and last day of each month. We also have reimbursement checks that are written to church members that purchase something for the church out of their own pocket and put in for a reimbursement . You will need to pick up all paid bills and take them back to the church and file them in our filing system. You would be shown how to file paid bills. It will be necessary to pick up reports that The Finance Committee needs to go over at our monthly meetings and make copies of the reports at the church. We would like you to attend Finance Committee meetings each month if at all possible. The Finance Committee meets on the second Monday of each month at 5:30 P.M.

This job should not take over an hour or two each week. If you have interest in this position please give me a call or talk to me at church. We need somebody to fill this position. I will be doing the accounting at Eagle Tax as I have done for the last year and a half. Eagle Tax pays all the bills. You will not have anything to do with that.

Randy, members of our youth group, and some adult individuals worked on the float all day. Our float was so pretty in the parade with all the Christmas lights. The float in the parade is great community outreach to the City of Oroville. This reminds everyone that there is a United Methodist Church right here in Oroville. We also remind people that Jesus is the reason for the Christmas season.

Pastor Dave also had his clown brigade in the parade. The clowns walked in front of our float. The clowns were Pastor Dave Rieck, Tracey Rieck, Rodrick Clay, Sem Xiong, and John Fowler. The clowns waved at the people watching the parade and then seven or eight times they stopped and put on a little show for the people watching the parade. This was a chair thing. The clowns lift the chairs over their heads and then catch the chairs. They did other things as well. The people loved it.

Thank you everyone that helped on the float and all that purchased tickets so we could have a float in the parade. This also helped our church budget at the same time with this fundraiser.

The church food pantry continues to help provide emergency food assistance for people in our community. Our wonderful office staff & Pastor Dave are the individuals who primarily give out food. Pastor Dave has met with a number of people when they come to the church needing food. If anyone approaches you when you are at the church asking about food, unless you feel it's an emergency & have time to help them, the normal distribution days & hours are when office is open.

People often ask me what is needed in the pantry. This changes often but here are the items which are most often needed. We can always use peanut butter & meat or fish (canned chicken, tuna, spam etc). Other items are: canned soup, pasta, chili etc. Please remember the food pantry is for non perishable items & the food needs to be commercially prepared (not home made) and not out of date.
