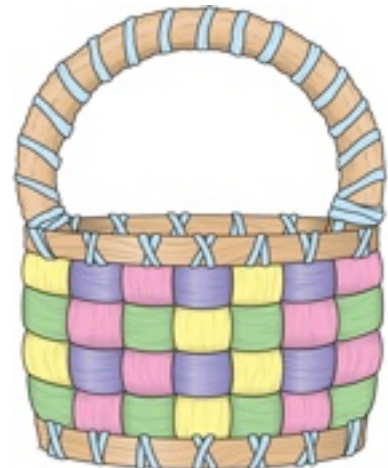

Bishop Announces Cabinet Change

Bishop Warner H. Brown, Jr. has announced a Cabinet change, effective July 1, 2012. After six years, the Rev. Jerry Smith (upper right) will be completing his service on the Cabinet. Rev. Smith is superintendent for the Great Northern District.



"I am extremely grateful for Jerry's faithful leadership during some challenging years for the California-Nevada Conference," the bishop said. "He has led the formation of the Great Northern District and has a deep love for that region of our Conference. We have benefited greatly from his service on the Cabinet and look forward to what he will bring to the Conference in the next phase of his ministry."

Six years is generally the standard term of service for a district superintendent.

The bishop has asked the Rev. David L. Samelson (lower right), pastor of First United Methodist Church of Eureka, to become the new superintendent to the Great Northern District on July 1.



Rev. Samelson is a graduate of Pacific School of Religion and Asbury Theological Seminary and has been a member of the California-Nevada Annual Conference since 1988. Before being appointed to Eureka First in 2006, he served at Greenville, Taylorsville, and Yreka UMCs. He currently is a circuit leader in the Great Northern District.

"I am delighted to welcome Dave Samelson to the Cabinet," Bishop Brown said. "He has a passion for the local church. His unique gifts of ministry will serve the Conference well in this role, as we continue to work toward a goal of more ably carrying out our mission of making disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world. Emergency Health Kits Needed

Over a year ago, we made health kits to send to UMCOR. Pastor Donna kept about 15 of them in the office to give to people who are homeless. Those kits have allowed people to get clean, comb their hair and to just feel human. We are down to our last bag. Please bring in supplies to fill more bags. The Confirmation Class will be over-seeing this project. Below are the pieces needed:

1 hand towel (15" x 25" up to 17" x 27")
1 washcloth
1 comb (large and sturdy, not pocket-sized)

1 nail file or fingernail clippers (no emery boards or toenail clippers)
1 bath-size bar of soap (3 oz. and up)
1 toothbrush (single brushes only in original wrapper, No child-size brushes)
1 large tube of toothpaste (4.5 oz or larger)
6 adhesive plastic strip sterile bandages
\$1 bill

Place these items inside a sealed one-gallon plastic bag.

New redwood grove memorialize Oroville educator Bruce Harmon

OROVILLE — A man who was known for deep involvement with Oroville education and the renovation of Harrison Stadium will be remembered perpetually with a new memorial.

The memorial is a grove of redwood trees planted recently on the visitor's side of the stadium in memory of the late Bruce Harmon.

The trees, now seven to eight feet tall, are expected to grow to 60 to 80-feet. "It will be a forest," said Oroville Union High School District maintenance and grounds supervisor Bill Tronson on Wednesday.

Harmon died in March. At the time of his death, he was a trustee on the Oroville City Elementary School District Board and the chairman of the renovation bond oversight committee. "We want it to be a memorial forest," said Tronson of the new grove. "He loved redwoods."

Tronson said that in addition to the trees and shrubs planted, there will be picnic tables installed later on.

"I think it will be a nice place so people can get in out of the sun," he said.

The trees were bought by the principal of Oroville Adult Education and given to OUHSD, and shrubbery for landscaping the stadium was already available.

Nonie Buis is working on providing a plaque to place at the site later. The area will be named the Bruce Harmon Memorial Forest.

Tronson said the high school district wanted to do the memorial, and he had promised it at Harmon's funeral. He added Harmon was very involved with the renovation project, watched the job every day, became friends with the workers, and wanted to learn everything he could about the process.

"He was a great person," Tronson said.
